<b>Job Description: IV Clinician/ Home Infusion Nurse</b>		
<p>The IV Clinician/ Home Infusion Nurse is a licensed registered nurse (RN) that provides infusion therapy patient care in the home, and other outpatient settings. The IV Clinician/ Home Infusion nurse implements infusion orders and uses nursing expertise to enhance pharmacy services, and tailor treatment and care plans to meet patient needs. The IV Clinician/ Home Infusion Nurse's skills include but are not limited to patient assessment, the infusion of various types of medications and fluids, vascular access device insertion and management, patient infusion education, and collaboration with medical and pharmacy personnel to foster continuity of care.</p>

3. Complies with HIPAA regulations and legal and ethical guidelines to safeguard patient confidentiality, and proprietary PICC Resource information	4. Promptly replies to visit assignment requests and notifications and performs the visits assigned on the PICC Resource patient visit schedule	
5. Obtains medical orders and pharmacist instructions, and clarifies orders as needed	6. Initiates and implements nursing plan of treatments with patient input	
7. Promptly communicates with PICC Resource nursing management, pharmacy, medical providers, and patients to improve patient care	8. Provides quality patient-centered care per the nursing plan of care, medical orders, and nursing plan of treatment orders	
9. Customizes patient education to the type of infusion therapy ordered, patient-specific education needs and plan of treatment goals	10. Assesses, evaluates, and documents patient responses to infusion therapy, and patients' physical and overall condition at each patient visit	
11. Responds to patient clinical changes by implementing adjustments to the nursing care plan and treatment orders in coordination with nursing management, pharmacy services, and the medical provider	12. Performs clinical documentation during visits and submits visit and other documentation, including timesheets to the PICC Resource office in a timely manner according to PICC Resource policies
