

PICC INSERTION CLINICAL

Overview - PICC Insertion Clinical Qualification Program

Referral of trainees for four days to one full week of one-to-one supervision in live PICC and Midline insertions. Trainees are precepted by an experienced PICC expert, and leader in the industry who has placed thousands of PICCs and Midlines. Number of insertions provided over one week average from fifteen to twenty five providing ample opportunity to become independent in insertions. To qualify for the program, trainees must meet the requirements outlined within this document.

Goals

At the end of the PICC Insertion Clinical, the trainee will be able to perform the following for PICC and/or Midline insertion procedures:

- Assess patients for suitability for PICC or Midline catheters
- Demonstrate proper set up and maintenance of sterile technique
- Successfully use ultrasound guidance and Modified Seldinger Technique to access arm veins
- Successfully insert and advance PICC and/or Midline catheters to the proper tip location
- Demonstrate proper set up and use of ECG tip confirmation systems
- Properly complete the procedure including: remove wire(s), apply dressing, caps, document, and report to facility.

Requirements

Program Fee: \$500.00 per day (4 day minimum, 7 day maximum). Pre-requisites: Completion of a PICC Resource Associates, LLC or PICC Excellence, Inc. qualified PICC and Midline Insertion Classes within the previous 12 months. Trainee credentials must match clinical site state guidelines for clinicians allowed to insert PICCs and Midlines. Prior to starting the clinical program:

- Full payment or a non-refundable 25% deposit is required with the program application. If application for the program is made with a deposit and/or payment plan; balance of the program fee must be received no later than 2 weeks prior to the 1st day of the PICC clinical. Financing is available through [BillMeLater](#), or our [3 to 4 month payment plan](#).
- Upon receipt of the program deposit, the PICC preceptor will send a video on sterile technique to the trainee to study prior to the clinical start date. On the first day of the clinical, the trainee will take a post test based on the video, and will work with the PICC preceptor on sterile technique and set up prior to starting the first patient case of the day.
- Trainees must separately pay and arrange for travel to the clinical site in Illinois. Trainees must separately pay for issuance of an Illinois and Indiana applicable clinical license.
- Proof of up to date: malpractice insurance, professional clinical license, driver's license, CPR certification, recent physical (and/or clearance to work directly with patients in clinical setting by MD/ or appropriate Licensed Independent Practitioner), flu vaccine, appropriate test results for: hepatitis titers and PPD.
- Training is one-to-one, no more than one trainee may be scheduled per session.
